Guidelines for Applicants:

Introduction.

The First Presbyterian Church of Springfield Student Opportunity Scholarship Program serves post-secondary school students who are active members of the church by providing need-based financial assistance for students who are full-time students attending accredited institutions in the United States. Students will have an opportunity to renew the scholarship provided they maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Application.

Go to <http://fpcspringfield.org/forms/scholarship-form/> to download the application and submit to the Finance Committee of First Presbyterian Church of Springfield. Students should outline their university or college name, their major area of study, their credit hours taken for the semester in which scholarship would be awarded, and their anticipated graduation date. Students may request a specific award amount and should state the need for use. Students who have received an award in the previous year must renew the application annually. Students renewing the application should state their current grade point average.

Eligibility.

First Presbyterian Church of Springfield members who are:

- a full time student at an accredited college or university in the United States.
- maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- demonstrate a need for financial assistance.

Administration:

Scholarship award will be approved and disbursed on a semester-by-semester basis and submitted to the student's college or university's financial aid department.
